

Chain of Responsibility Policy – Blogg’s Engineering

Blogg’s Engineering undertakes civil and building construction and site fabrication for mining, oil and gas and industrial projects (greenfield and brownfield) in metropolitan, regional and remote areas of New South Wales.

Blogg’s Engineering transports goods to regional areas and receives delivery of goods to regional sites. The company complies with Chain of Responsibility (CoR) laws to make sure everyone in the supply chain shares equal responsibility for ensuring breaches of the Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) do not occur.

To ensure compliance under CoR laws, Blogg’s Engineering has these measures in place:

- Ensuring contractual arrangements and documentation for the consignment and delivery of goods enable compliance with the HVNL.
- Contingency planning concerning consignments and delivery times.
- Requesting information about what systems and controls are in place to ensure compliance.
- Ensuring there are no arrangements which encourage or reward non-compliance.
- Working with suppliers to provide forward advice of orders to allow adequate order planning and delivery times for all deliveries.
- Requesting that suppliers comply with CoR laws and requirements on all deliveries.
- Advising clients that the company supports compliance with CoR requirements.

Company management is fully committed to meeting its responsibilities under CoR laws and seeks to lead by example.
